

Upgrade Guide: Capturx for ArcGIS 1.3

The 1.3 release of Capturx for ArcGIS now includes support for ArcGIS Desktop 10.0 (SP2 or SP3).

Your purchase of Capturx for ArcGIS 1.2.x included one year of Capturx Software Assurance, which entitles you to unlimited software updates and upgrades – including the 1.3 release.

If you bought Capturx for ArcGIS Desktop software within the past 12 months, or you work for an organization which signed-up for an Adapx Software Assurance agreement, you are qualified for a free upgrade to Capturx for ArcGIS Desktop 1.3.

Part 1. Preparing for Upgrade from previous versions of Capturx for ArcGIS:

To avoid workflow disruptions, we suggest that you plan for the upgrade in advance.

You will need to upload all the data from your digital pens BEFORE upgrading to Capturx for ArcGIS 1.3. Note: maps printed with Capturx for ArcGIS 1.2.x can be used with Capturx for ArcGIS 1.3.

- Import all previous ink sessions
 - Capturx for ArcGIS 1.3 will require you to import all Capturx for ArcGIS 1.2.x ink sessions from your pen before upgrading.

Part 2. Performing the Upgrade

Step A. First, Uninstall ArcGIS Desktop 9.x, Capturx Pen Manager, and Capturx for ArcGIS Desktop 1.2.x.

Go to Windows Control Panel > Programs > Programs and Features

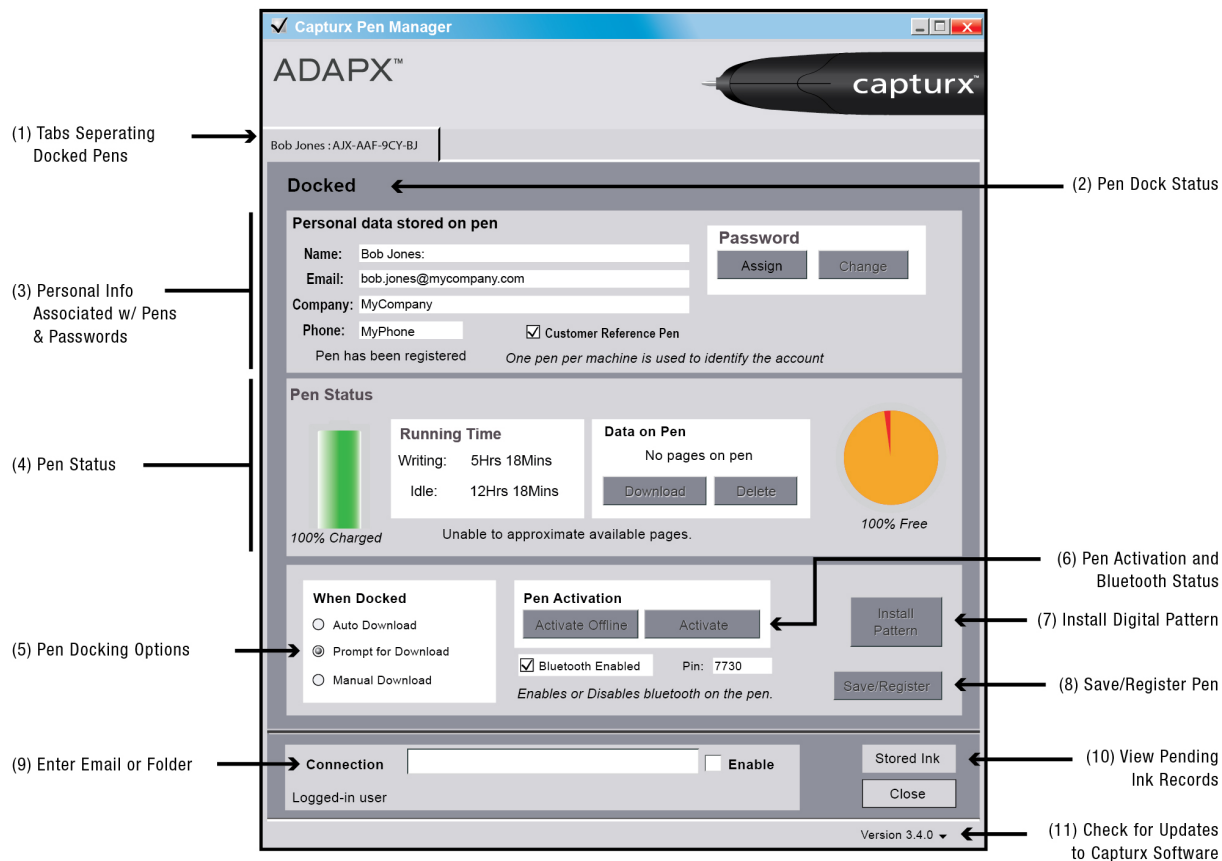
- Reboot your system after uninstall is complete.
- Install ArcGIS Desktop 10.0 before Step B.

Step B. Install Capturx Pen Manager

1. Insert the shipped DVD or click on the provided download link.
2. When prompted to "Run" or "Save", click "Run".
3. The Installer will self-extract and start the InstallShield Wizard.
4. Simply follow the installation software prompts

Step C. Install Capturx for ArcGIS 1.3

1. Insert the shipped DVD or click on the provided download link
2. When prompted to "Run" or "Save", click "Run".
3. The Installer will self-extract and start the InstallShield Wizard.
4. Simply follow the installation software prompts.
5. Reboot your system after installation is complete.



Step D. Activate and register your software and digital pen.

Follow the steps shown on the screen to activate 1.3 and register your existing Capturx pen.

REMINDER: Redlining and Adding Features.

By default you are in redline/markup mode, so you don't have to touch a legend icon to get started. However, if you wish to add features, first touch the feature legend item before marking on the map.
